Only through the Hope in Christ do we see a brighter future on this reservation! We fully believe in the power of prayer and pray often. As 2010 unfolds, we eagerly welcome our first Native team members! The numbers of these friends grows; serving both in the home-building aspects of ARM and our Children's Ministries as well. We are also earnestly working toward appointing Natives to our Board of Directors.

# God's *ARMs* Around the Reservation

## Macaiah Hill's Story



Macaiah is no stranger to those serving with Arizona Reservation Ministries. In fact, those that have served through ARM since 2002 have had the privilege of watching Macaiah grow into the man of God he is becoming.

Macaiah first joined in the children's ministries of ARM through our mobile ministries at 12 years old, along with his identical twin brother, Micah, and younger brother, "Blue."

Over the years, Macaiah traveled with various ARM youth leaders to present a Vacation Bible School to children on the Navajo Reservation, to help build two homes in partnership with ARM, Amor Ministries and Arizona churches, and youth events. Through all of this, and the mentorship of a godly father, Macaiah grew in his knowledge of Christ. He also saw the possibilities; the opportunities to serve Him.

As Macaiah graduated from Globe High School in 2009, he decided to

spend his summer doing what he'd already been doing when able; volunteering with our home construction to learn the trade, and help those of the San Carlos Apache Tribe. The volunteering continued throughout the fall.

In December of 2009, Macaiah applied, interviewed and was hired as a member of the team of Arizona Reservation Ministries.

His schedule is very full! Macaiah is now working nearly every day with the construction needs of this ministry; primarily building homes for the homeless, but also other projects as needed. He has become a skilled craftsman in many areas of the construction field. He's also endeared himself to many from across the US as he shares his life and experiences as a member of the San Carlos Apache Tribe.



## How You Can Help Macaiah...

Macaiah needs your help! As he worked alongside the volunteers that joined ARM during the spring, summer and fall of 2009, many friendships were formed. Macaiah has a strong work ethic, AND a great sense of humor! We are praying that through those that met him, his support might be raised.

Two significant gifts were provided as 2009 drew to a close to subsidize Macaiah's support temporarily. Already, one partner has agreed to send in \$100 each month to provide for his on-going needs. We need others to do the same. He needs \$1,600-\$2,000 each month to cover his salary.

Please pray about helping Macaiah continue to serve through this ministry. AS a young Apache Christian, it is essential that he remain on this team, as one day it is our prayer to hand over all the activities of San Carlos to Apache Christians, then spread to one of the 22 other reservations within the State of Arizona.

Please also consider committing to pray daily for Macaiah as this young man steps into such a critical adventure.
