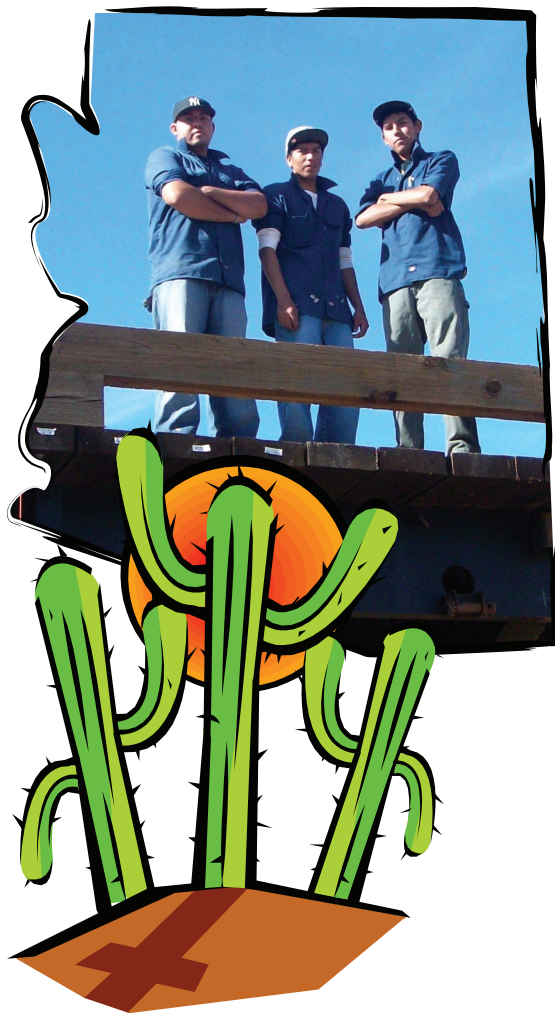

ARM exists to make disciples, empowering our Native brothers and sisters to meet the physical and spiritual needs of their community, motivating them to become active members of local, Bible-based churches. ARM assists in many ways!

Currently, ARM's are provided for Home-building, children's and youth ministries from our mobile ministry centers, hosting prayer journeys around the reservation with visitors from across the US, mentoring teens/adults, partnering with Apache churches and an Apache-led ministry, Bible studies and more!

Only through the Hope in Christ do we see a brighter future on this reservation! We fully believe in the power of prayer and pray often. As 2010 unfolds, we eagerly welcome our first Native team members! The numbers of these friends grows; serving both in the home-building aspects of ARM and our Children's Ministries as well. We are also earnestly working toward appointing Natives to our Board of Directors.

Meet the A Team

God has created a team who work well, play well, and represent Christ well together. Mac, Guy and Mike have been friends for several years, all living on the San Carlos Apache Reservation, and all graduating from Globe High School in 2009.

This self-proclaimed "A Team" has been an incredible blessing to Arizona Reservation Ministries, and the San Carlos Apache Tribe as they work together to complete homes for those in tremendous need, or other projects as needed, working with volunteers who arrive often from across the United States with a variety of talents...and ages. Their own personalities and talents are diverse, adding much strength; physical and spiritual, and comedy as the entire ARM Team seeks to provide "God's ARMs around the reservation."

These members of the "A Team" are no strangers to those serving with Arizona Reservation Ministries. Each had attended our mobile ministries, learning both the Word and how to use it through various activities.



MACAIAH HILL

We first met Mac at 10 years old, along with his identical twin brother, Micah, and younger brother, "Blue" as they attended their "Church Bus."

Over the years, Macaiah traveled with various ARM youth leaders to

present a Vacation Bible School to children on the Navajo Reservation, to help build two homes in partnership with ARM, Amor Ministries and

Arizona churches, and youth events. Through all of this, and the mentorship of a godly father, Macaiah grew in his knowledge of Christ. He also saw the possibilities; the opportunities to serve Him. Upon graduation, Mac volunteered with ARM, learning the many phases of home-building.

In December of 2009, Mac joined the ARM team full-time. Since then, he has become the authority on construction sites, capable of all phases of home-building, and confident as he leads the many short-term ministry volunteers and the other members of the "A Team."

GUY MAY

Guy also attended ARM's mobile ministries for several years, going with groups to California and also helping with that VBS on the Navajo Reservation. Joining the ARM team in May of 2010, Guy is a quiet observer, knowing when his help is needed, and filling in capably to complete the tasks; watching as each week a new group of volunteers with varied talents arrive to pick up where the last left off on the completion of ARM construction projects.

Guy is working on a degree in Fire Science, working with ARM as much as able as a diligent worker.



MIKE ROMAN

Mike Roman, from New York and now living in San Carlos began helping his two friends in the summer of 2010. Hired shortly after, he often adds the less subtle comic relief as the three bring an element of fun to long days of home-building. Like Guy, Mike is also attending college classes to obtain his degree

in Fire Science while working as able with ARM.

Both Guy and Mike have something else to be proud of: Before graduating from Globe High School, these two were members of the school's baseball team, winning State Championship rings.



This A Team needs your help! As they work alongside the flow of volunteers who arrive, they have the opportunity of meeting their spiritual siblings from across the US. We are praying that through those that meet them, their support might be raised.

Currently, the great majority of their support must come from ARM's general funds. Twice now, they've been told there were no funds to pay them. During the summer of 2010 when this occurred, their response was that they would simply volunteer until funds again arrived. The "A" of the "A Team" may stand for many things, but to the ARM team, "A" stands for "Amazing."

As young Apache Christians, it is essential that they remain on this team, as one day it is our prayer to hand over all the activities of San Carlos to Apache Christians. They have proven many times that their "hands" are capable of that responsibility. Please also consider committing to pray daily for one of these A Team members. Standing up for Christ as a young man on the San Carlos Apache Reservation is a bold step in a very strong spiritual battle.
