

Arizona Reservation Ministries

Was established in April of 2002 to provide 'God's ARMs around the reservation.' ARM exists to make disciples, empowering our Native brothers and sisters to meet the physical and spiritual needs of their community, motivating them to become active members of Apache-led, Bible-based churches. ARM assists in many ways!

Currently, ARMs are provided for home-building, children's and youth ministries from our Mobile Ministry Center, hosting prayer journeys around the Reservation with visitors from across the US, partnering with Apache-led churches and Tribal agencies, Bible studies and more! ARM's focus is to not only partner with our Native brothers and sisters, in the ministries God has placed them in within the Reservation, but to also fill *this* ministry with Native Team members. Of the 12 on our team today, three are from the San Carlos Apache Nation. One member of our Board of Directors come from this Reservation. It is our intent to seek other faith-filled Native believers to serve through this ministry as God leads and provides.

ONLY through the Hope Christ offers can we envision a brighter future on the Reservation. We fully believe in the power of prayer and pray often. We have witnessed innumerable miracles as God has guided and provided for this ministry! What we honestly need most is **your** prayers. Thanks for reading about us, and Thank you for praying!

Jon spends his days working primarily through

the construction/house-building & maintenance ministries of ARM. Assisting in all phases of construction, his assistance is critical in completing homes for those in desperate need, a church sanctuary for an Apache-led congregation, and more.

The skills required include not only construction tasks, but encouraging and overseeing the labors of volunteers from the US that join ARM in Short-Term Ministry. These volunteers range in age from Junior High school through senior citizens.

Because of Jon's faith and heart for ministry, relationships have been formed as he works closely with these volunteers, and with those of the San Carlos Apache Nation he serves alongside, or who will receive a new home or church home. Jon is a missionary, using construction to lead many to the Lord.



Linda serves as needed on ARM's Church Bus Team. After several years as a

volunteer through this branch of ARM, relationships have been formed with many children and teens of San Carlos. With four of her own children to care for, much of her tasks are now transitioning to office tasks...but those relationships have led many to call her "Mom" and through texting, facebook and more, her influence continues to bear fruit.

In addition to Church Bus visits, special activities occur often! Linda is a great blessing as Family Fun Days, Carnivals, Baptism Celebrations occur. She also labors with our two tremendous annual projects: Our Backpack project before school resumes each year, and our Christmas Stocking/Fleece Blanket project.
