Was established in April of 2002 to provide 'God's ARMs around the reservation.' ARM exists to make disciples, empowering our Native brothers and sisters to meet the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of their community, motivating them to become active members of Apache-led, Bible-based churches. ARM assists in many ways!

Currently, ARMs are provided for home-building, children's and youth ministries from our Mobile Ministry Center, hosting prayer journeys around the Reservation with visitors from across the US, partnering with Apache-led churches and Tribal agencies, Bible studies and more! ARM's focus is to not only partner with our Native brothers and sisters, in the ministries God has placed them in within the Reservation, but to also fill *this* ministry with Native Team members. Of the 11 on our team today, four are from the San Carlos Apache Nation. One member of our Board of Directors comes from this Reservation. It is our intent to seek other faith-filled Native believers to serve through this ministry as God leads and provides.

ONLY through the Hope Christ offers can we envision a brighter future on the Reservation. We fully believe in the power of prayer and pray often. We have witnessed innumerable miracles as God has guided and provided for this ministry! What we honestly need most is **your** prayers. Thanks for reading about us, and Thank you for praying!


The Chronicles of Kevin



Kevin Pleasant's journey to ARM truly began in 1995 at the age of seven when he had a dream about being in "a desert full of green" and heard a voice tell him to "go forth."

Not yet knowing all that God had in store, Kevin put his dream aside, but continued to feel God's call on his life. By 2016 Kevin had completed a preaching certification course, served as a children's minister and led an in-home Bible study, all while working a 'day job' at a local public library.

In June of 2016 Kevin felt God's call to full time ministry and began to pray for direction. This prayer was answered with a clear call to go to Arizona and after a quick internet search; Kevin found the desert of green from his dreams on the



San Carlos Apache Reservation. Soon after, God provided an opportunity for Kevin to visit Arizona Reservation Ministries as part of a Short Term Ministry Team from New Albany Indiana. During

this trip, the ARM Team realized Kevin's willingness and desire to serve. It was on the Church Bus that his heart for the Apache People was most evident. These missionaries had been praying for someone to join in the critical area of Children's and Youth Ministries. After a week of intensive prayer by both Kevin and the ARM team, it was clear Arizona Reservation Ministries had found their



newest team member, and Kevin had found his home.

Kevin and two friends made the 1,630 mile trek from Indiana in April of 2017. These two friends helped bring

his home with him. He's residing in that RV, now serving full-time through ARM working primarily in Children's and Youth Ministries. This past June, an overnight event was planned for teens of San Carlos. As part of the team who planned this event, it became clear that a special Youth Group was beginning. Now, Kevin spends his days working primarily through ARM's Teen Ministry as one of those leading in such a critical area of need at a church the Lord provided on the Reservation for evangelism and discipleship, counseling and crazy games.

Although those tasks require a lot of time, Kevin is also busy as needed with

organizing Christmas and back-to-school projects, and more!



As part of the 'Bus Team', Kevin has quickly become a familiar face to the children of San Carlos. Once the Church Bus rolls again (we're praying for someone to join us as the Bus driver), Kevin joins in teaching a lesson, planning and presenting a craft time or playing a game of tag. His eagerness to help and desire to share God's love with all the kids and teens has already made him a welcome addition to the ARM team. Outside of the weekly Youth meetings, special activities such as Family Fun Days, Carnivals, and Baptism Celebrations are regular occurrences. Kevin's financial needs are provided by those the Lord calls to partner with him. He is fully living by faith!
