In May of 2024, we started the process of enlarging their kitchen/dining area and then adding living and sleeping space. Their current living room was transformed into a bedroom for kids seeking refuge during all of this construction. Their new living room, although FAR from completed was their gathering place for Christmas. We're so grateful for those who came this past year to help us work on this project, which is nearing completion!

In February of 2025, the trenches were dug for a new foundation, to become a new and safer home for this Pastor and his family. We're so excited to be able to serve as God's builders. Providing a craft and game to coincide with our lessons to the children and teens regarding God's Army of Angels and Spiritual Warfare was great fun. A small team then came from Palm Valley Church in Goodyear and Buckeye, AZ the 28th-20th of March. A sweet mother brought her children who worked hard alongside the other adults, blessing many.
