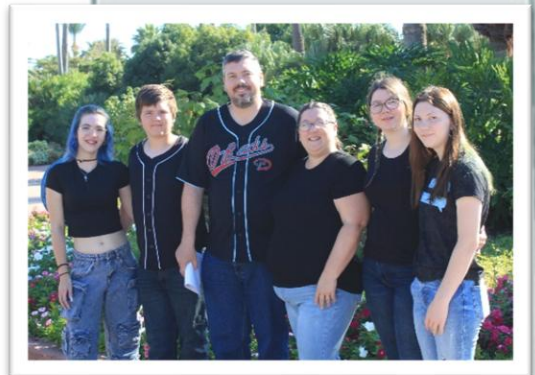

Arizona Reservation Ministries...

Was established in March of 2002 to provide 'God's ARMs around the reservation.' ARM exists to make disciples, empowering our Native brothers and sisters to meet the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of their community, motivating them to become active members of local, Bible-based churches. ARM assists in many ways!

Currently, ARMs are provided for home-building, church-building, children's and youth ministries, hosting prayer journeys around the Reservation with visitors from across the U.S., partnering with Apache-led churches and Tribal agencies, the distribution of Critical Care items, Bible studies and more! ARM's focus is to not only partner with our Native brothers and sisters in the ministries God has placed them in within the Reservation, but to also fill *this* ministry with Native Team members. Of the twelve on our team today, eight are from the San Carlos Apache Nation. It is our intent to seek other faith-filled Native believers to serve through this ministry as God leads and provides. We have others we're hoping to hire soon; simply waiting for others to catch this vision and assist with their monthly support.

ONLY through the Hope Christ offers can we envision a brighter future on the Reservation. We fully believe in the power of prayer and pray often! We have witnessed innumerable miracles as God has guided and provided for this ministry! What we honestly need most is **your** prayers. Thanks for reading about us and thank you for praying!

As a third-grader, Jon Lawrence joined the mission field as part of the Dale Lawrence family. As the years passed, Jon's career led him on his own journey, living for a time in Mesa, AZ. It was in Mesa that he met his lovely bride, Linda, marrying her in 2004. After being married only a few months, their interest with Arizona Reservation

Ministries led them to move eastward to Globe, AZ. Over the next several years, their assistance as volunteers was a blessing to both the ministry and those ministered to. As their children arrived, they, too, became part of the relationships formed with those of the San Carlos Apache Nation.

Jasmine (2006), Andi (2008), Morgan (2010) and Edward (2011) were all held and cuddled as infants by children on ARM's Church Bus who have always felt that this Lawrence family was *their* family as well.

In December of 2012, both Jon and Linda felt called to begin full-time service through Arizona Reservation Ministries.

Jon serves as ARM's Short Term Ministry Coordinator, through which he gets to interact with all of those whose partnership with us in such a practical way impact so

Because of Jon's faith and heart for ministry, relationships have been formed as he works closely with these visiting Short-Term volunteers, the ARM Team, and with those of the San Carlos Apache Nation he serves alongside, Jon is a missionary, using all of the gifts the Lord has provided to reap a harvest for the Kingdom.

She is the one that plans, shops for and prepares meals for our Short-Term Ministry Teams and special events. Many children and teens call Linda "Mom." many. These volunteers range in age from junior high school through senior citizens. He also helps keep many

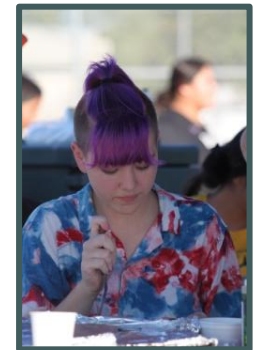
efficiently and are held in ways that honor the Lord.
