Was established in March of 2002 to provide 'God's ARMs around the reservation.' ARM exists to make disciples, empowering our Native brothers and sisters to meet the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of their community, motivating them to become active members of local, Bible-based churches. ARM assists in many ways!

Currently, ARMs are provided for home-building, church-building, children's and youth ministries, hosting prayer journeys around the Reservation with visitors from across the U.S., partnering with Apache-led churches and Tribal agencies, the distribution of Critical Care items, Bible studies and more! ARM's focus is to not only partner with our Native brothers and sisters in the ministries God has placed them in within the Reservation, but to also fill *this* ministry with Native Team members. Of the twelve on our team today, eight are from the San Carlos Apache Nation. It is our intent to seek other faith-filled Native believers to serve through this ministry as God leads and provides. We have others we're hoping to hire soon; simply waiting for others to catch this vision and assist with their monthly support.

ONLY through the Hope Christ offers can we envision a brighter future on the Reservation. We fully believe in the power of prayer and pray often! We have witnessed innumerable miracles as God has guided and provided for this ministry! What we honestly need most is **your** prayers. Thanks for reading about us and thank you for praying!

A Pastor and his Family's ARMs Around the Reservation



Vincent began volunteering with ARM's Construction Crew in October of 2018, officially joining the team soon after. Already recognized as a leader at the Apache-led American Indian Church, he and wife, Vermaleen have grown immensely in

the various areas of ministry the Lord has called them to.

Vermaleen added a Food Pantry to their tasks in 2024 as an area of their church sanctuary now holds donated items. Oftentimes, she also delivers Critical Care items to those in great need. Several hundreds of thousands of pounds of provisions have been distributed to families that even the Tribe's Social Services are unaware of; on dirt roads, within shacks and worse. Sharing prayers, encouraging words and more are always part of



their deliveries, meeting both physical and spiritual needs.

Vermaleen is now our Children's Minister within the children's ministries of ARM, leading her team, planning and presenting lessons to 100+ children and teens four afternoons each week.



Their children, Seth and Aurelia, serve in the sound booth during services at the

church, and with other tasks as needed. Seth is now a hard working young man at a fast-food restaurant in the area while also a high school senior. Aurelia is receiving many honors as a high-achieving student in 5th grade.

We were thrilled to be able to provide our 37th home...a parsonage for the American Indian Church where the Stevens family resides just next to the church in May of 2021. Geographically, this area sits along an area where many walk, seeking Christ...or drugs. Having them strategically placed

there speaks of their faith, and willingness to serve at all hours, those who are in desperate need of the Love of Jesus. Vermaleen is able to organize.

Vincent and Vermaleen continue to serve as Co-Pastors of the American Indian Church. Hosting weekly prayer meetings, classes and worship services, they are very busy! Vincent has performed innumerable funerals and weddings.



In August of 2025, their prayers to travel as missionaries were answered in a very powerful way! They were invited to join another ministry, traveling to Turkey on a missions/prayer trek. Vincent, Vermaleen and Aurelia stepped out in great faith for this journey, increasing

both their faith and the Kingdom as well.

As mentioned, Vincent, Vermaleen, Seth and Aurelia serve the Lord through ARM as a family. Each capably serves with the gifts the Lord has given them, celebrating the fact that they can serve Him together; a family within the "family" of Arizona Reservation Ministries.
